

Public Skate Rules

- 1. Skating in a manner that endangers or interferes with other skaters' safety or pleasure is strictly forbidden.
- 2. Roughness, excessive speeding or weaving through other skaters is prohibited.
- 3. No patron organized tag or games of any kind are permitted on or off the ice.
- 4. No more than two people may skate together.
- 5. No one is permitted on the ice without skates.
- 6. Skaters must keep moving while on the ice. No sitting or lying down on the ice.
- 7. No jumps above single Lutz, basic spins only; No camel spins or backward spirals. Forward spirals MUST be conducted during lessons only with the coach following right behind for safety.
- 8. No eating or drinking is permitted on the ice.
- 9. Skaters are not allowed to carry children or secondary items such as cameras, handbags, backpacks, etc. while skating.
- 10. Patrons must not sit on, lean over or leave articles on the dasher boards.
- 11. Exits are to be kept clear at all times.
- 12. No dogs or pets of any kind are permitted on the premises.
- 13. Incidents of malicious destruction are to be reported to a supervisor immediately.
- 14. Nobody is allowed on the ice during resurfacings.
- 15. Any disagreement with a patron who violates a rule must be referred to the manager or supervisor on duty.
- 16. Throwing snowballs (or any other objects) is strictly prohibited.
- 17. Persons who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or other substances are not permitted in the arena. Refer to manager.
